

## IMIBIC offers prestigious Marie Skłodowska-Curie Fellowships in Córdoba, Spain

1<sup>st</sup> October 2019, Córdoba, Spain - IMIBIC Fellowship Programme for Personalised and Precision Medicine (IMIBIC-P<sup>2</sup>Med) Call for Proposals is open for applications until the 10<sup>th</sup> of January 2020.

IMIBIC-P<sup>2</sup>Med is a new Fellowship Programme that will attract talented researchers of any nationality to work at the Maimonides Biomedical Research institute of Cordoba (IMIBIC) in Córdoba, south of Spain.

The programme offers 6 Fellowships of up to 3 years to experienced researchers. The selected Fellows will be nominated as Marie Skłodowska-Curie Fellows. These Fellowships are well known worldwide and recognised as one of the most prestigious fellowships in Europe.

The Fellowships are targeted to experienced researchers of any nationality. Researchers holding a PhD, or researchers with equivalent experience, are eligible. In addition, eligible applicants shall not have resided or carried out their main activity in Spain for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the deadline of the call.

To apply, the fellowship applicants must propose an innovative research project in line with one of the scientific programmes of IMIBIC. The evaluation by a panel of external and international experts in the field will ensure an open, transparent, and merit based selection process.

The MSCA Fellows will carry out their research projects within the research groups of IMIBIC, and under the supervision of the group leader. They will also have an opportunity to plan research stays and training activities at several other national and international organisations that collaborate with the programme.

IMIBIC-P<sup>2</sup>Med is co-funded by the European Union's Horizon 2020 MSCA-Actions and the University of Cordoba, the Regional Government of Andalusia, and the Foundation for Biomedical Research of Córdoba.
